COSTS  The fee for a typical evaluation for competency to stand trial and mental status at the time of the alleged offense is \$950, plus travel mileage if applicable. The fee for Capital Murder Initial Evaluations is \$1,500 minimum. This includes review of past medical records, consultation with attorney, consultation with other collateral witnesses when available, evaluation of the client, and preparation of the report. This is not a full mitigation study, but an initial examination to determine competence to stand trial and mental status at the time of the alleged offense. In exceptional cases in which significantly more time is required, time will be billed accordingly. If intelligence is in question, the administration of an IQ test costs an additional \$550. If the defendant is transported to our office in Hattiesburg, we offer a 10% discount of all professional fees. If court testimony is required, these services are billed at \$200 per hour, in full-day increments. We deal directly with the county on fee collections, provided you obtain in the court order the authorization of payment.
<b>REPORT TURNAROUND TIME</b> We schedule the evaluation upon receipt of the information listed above. Written reports are typically submitted within three to four weeks of the examination.
